

- Need to decide WHICH words, HOW to study, how to REMEMBER




# Think about Vocabulary

## What You Know When You Know a Word



- Meaning: car / a four-wheeled road
  vehicle / / automobile
- Word form (noun, verb, adjective, adverb): photo / photograph / photographic…
- **Spelling:** there / their / they're
- Pronunciation: Camosun=kə'mosən
- How to use it / associated words: snow is falling / snowman, snowball / snow,rain,sun /

## Retention

#### REMEMBERING

- Pay attention analyze
- 5+ times meeting a word to remember
- Multisensory (read it, hear it, write it)
- Associations (story, humour, themes, categories)
- Associations with other words (phrases)

Vocabulary Learning Tip -Keep a vocabulary notebook -Not much time? Start with the spelling, translation, synonyms, and an example sentence



## **Vocabulary Practice**

- Listen / read IN CONTEXT
- Do something with the word (positive/negative, rank, categorize, connect with related ideas)
- Speak / write it in sentences
- Use free practice websites


