# REFERENCE LIST EXAMPLE

### References

Brawn, B. T. (2007). The double take: Cognition and information college athletes who do weight training. *Journal of Coed Spo* 1-14. https://doi.org/10.4444/123059700

- Last page of your assignment
- Title "References" is centred and bold
- Text is double-spaced
- First line of entry is all the way to the left; next lines use a "hanging indent"
- Entries are in alphabetical order

Gimrat, E. (2011). Objects in gym mirrors may appear larger than they are. In G. C. Sexsmith (Ed.), Recent Research in the Psychology of Sport (pp. 59-68). Macho Man Press.

APA 7 reference list entries include **four key pieces of information**, presented in the following order:

- AUTHOR: Who is responsible for this work?
- DATE: When was this work published?
- TITLE: What is this work called?
- SOURCE: Where can I retrieve this work?

APA 7 references use one of two font style patterns:

- ITALICTITLE for works that stand alone
  - books, reports, dissertations, etc:

Wilk, M. J. (2021). Sorrentino's Canadian textbook for the support worker (5th ed.). Elsevier Canada.

- ITALIC SOURCE for works that are part of a greater whole
  - journal, magazine, & newspaper articles; podcast episodes; blog posts; etc:

NOTE: The name of the source is in *italics*, but for online sources, the url or doi is in regular font style.

### **Book Format**

**BOOKS** 

Author, A.A. (date). Title of book: Subtitle information (edition). Publisher.

# **Example:**

Wilk, M. J. (2021). Sorrentino's Canadian textbook for the support worker (5th ed.). Elsevier Canada.

# FAMILY NAME OR FIRST (GIVEN) NAME?

- Melissa Robinson Robinson is the family name, AKA "last name"
  - Melissa is the given name, AKA "first" name
  - We say and write the given name BEFORE the family name in English
- Robinson, Melissa
  - In some records, we organize authors by family name.
  - The comma tells you the family name has been written first, followed by the given name



- Robinson, M.
  - In reference lists, APA requires the last name first, followed by the initial letter of the given name and a period
- (Robinson, 2022)
  - For in-text citations, APA requires only the family name

# REFERENCE LIST FORMAT PRACTICE: ONLINE MAGAZINE/NEWSPAPER/JOURNAL ARTICLE

### **Online Article Format**

Author, A. A. (date). Title of article. Newspaper/Magazine Name. URL

# REFERENCE LIST FORMAT PRACTICE: WEBPAGEWITH NO AUTHOR OR DATE



### **Format**

Website Name. (n.d.). Title of webpage. URL

### With no author or date:

- The name of the website takes the author 'spot' in your citation.
- Don't need to repeat the website name
- Put (n.d.) = no date

### **Example**:

Small Business B.C. (n.d.). How to start selling on Amazon. https://smallbusinessbc.ca/education/how-to-start-selling-on-amazon-2022-10-05/

# REFERENCE LIST FORMAT PRACTICE: D2L PPT SLIDES (OR OTHER FORMATS)



### **Format**

Author, A.A. (date). Title of file [Format]. Name of Site. URL



- Save time/trouble by writing down source information (URLs, etc.) in your research notes
   Ask your librarian about reference tools like RefWorks, CitationMachine, etc.
- Notice how other writers fit citations into their sentence style – get help at the Writing Centre
- Keep Camosun Library's <u>APA Quick Guide</u> handy: you will need it!

# Most importantly, remember:

Doing citations correctly takes TIME – sometimes a lot!


- write down source info when researching
- give yourself time to draft/edit your citations
